The richly colored statues of Ebisu, the deity of fishery, which can be seen here and there indicate the deep relationship between Uku island and the sea. Surrounded by rich nature and decorated with the history of defeated warriors of the Heike clan, Uku is a treasure island filled with islanders' warm hearts.



Bishamon-ji Temple

Founded in 1188 as the Uku family's private temple for praying. The enshrined statues in the temple are Bishamonten Heaven King, the great priest Kobo Daishi, and so on.




Kojima Shrine


